The Institute for Plasma Research (IPR), an autonomous institution under the Department of Atomic Energy (DAE), Government of India, is an internationally renowned research institute carrying out basic and applied research in plasma physics, thermonuclear fusion and other related areas.

Director, IPR : IPR is looking for a person with bright academic background and excellent leadership qualities to guide, promote and motivate the scientists and other employees of the Institute. He should be competent to manage human and financial resources assigned to the Institute in line with the results based pragmatic approach, and will be responsible to implement the programs of the Institute. He will also have close interactions with Constituent Units of the Department of Atomic Energy; other Research Organizations and Universities in India and abroad. IPR plays a major role in the International Thermonuclear Experimental Reactor (ITER) project at Cadarache, France, in which India is a Member.

Educational background: Candidate should be an eminent scientist with bright academic background preferably with Ph.D., and high quality R & D track record in the area of plasma sciences and related technologies.

Experience: The candidate should have adequate experience in a senior level managing large Scientific group / Project /Institute.

Age: The Applicant should not be below 45 years.

Remuneration : IPR follows the scale of pay admissible to Central Government employees. Director, IPR will be placed in the scale of pay of Rs.37400 – 67000 (plus grade pay Rs.10000) or higher scale of pay [i.e. Rs.67000 (annual increment @3%) – 79000 or Rs. 75500 – 80000] depending upon the merit and experience of the candidate. In addition, the post carries allowances as admissible to central government employees stationed at Gandhinagar, Gujarat.

The post will fall vacant on February 1, 2012.

The term of Director, IPR will be for a period of five years from the date of appointment or until 60 years of age, whichever is earlier, which may be extended at the discretion of the Council with the approval of the Government of India.

Selection: Appointment will be made by Government of India on the recommendation of a Search-cum-selection Committee.
