About IPR: Institute for Plasma Research (IPR) is an autonomous R&D organisation under the Department of Atomic Energy (DAE). This Institute is largely involved in theoretical and experimental studies in plasma science including basic plasma physics, magnetically confined hot plasmas and plasma technologies for industrial applications. The Institute operates two tokamaks – ADITYA and Steady State Tokamak (SST-1). FCIPT and ITER-India located at Gandhinagar and CPP-IPR located at Guwahati are three divisions under IPR.

About Ahmedabad/Gandhinagar: Ahmedabad is known as Amdavad (<u>Gujarati</u> pronunciation) is the largest city and former capital of <u>Gujarat</u>. Ahmedabad is located on the banks of the <u>Sabarmati River</u>. Ahmedabad has emerged as an important economic and industrial hub in India. It is the second largest producer of <u>cotton</u> in India.

Places to visit

Gandhi Ashram - For many years Ahmedabad was the center of Mahatma Gandhi's non-violent struggle for India's independence. He learnt the art of spinning and weaving, and soon the ashram began to buzz with khadi, not just as a way of producing clothes, but also as a way of thought. You can get a sense of his life, the history of the movement and those who worked alongside him, at the Gandhi Smarak Sangrahalaya, a small museum that includes excellent pictorial and written documentation, a library of Gandhian literature and paintings, and an immense archive of letters written by Gandhiji, every single one on the back of used paper.

Street Shopping - Street shopping is very popular in Ahmedabad and the <u>Law Garden</u> is a public garden in the city of Ahmedabad. The market outside the garden is very famous for the handicraft goods sold by local people during the evenings and night. One can test one's bargaining abilities while buying the textile and hand made jewellery sold here.

Sabarmati Riverfront - Sabarmati Riverfront is a waterfront being developed along the banks of Sabarmati river. Proposed in 1960s, the construction began in 2005. The major objectives of project are environment improvement, social infrastructure and sustainable development. Also, it has succeeded in restoring the city's relationship with its river. The project is two-level promenade situated on both sides of the river where the lower level serves only pedestrians and cyclists while the upper level is capable of hosting numerous cultural and educational events, leisure activities, large public parks and plazas and a few areas for commercial and retail development.

Akshardham - Akshardham is majestic, intricately carved stone structure which stands amid sprawling gardens. Inspiring episodes and incidents from the glorious history of Sanatan Dharma are presented in sound and light form for the benefit of the visitors. The wisdom of the Vedas, the epics, the Puranas is depicted on a crowded canvas by the exhibition. The visitor comes face to face with personages who have made this land what it is. It is a perfect mix of modernity and ancient values. 'The Hall of Harmony projects world religions side by side. So far millions of people who have visited have been able to savour the story of Hinduism and to imbibe the message of universal peace and brotherhood.

Adalaj Step Well - This vav (well) has served as a resting place for hundreds of years for many pilgrims and caravans along their trade routes. Built in 1499, this five-storey step well was not just a cultural and utilitarian space, but also a spiritual refuge. There is an opening in the ceilings above the landing which allows the light and air to enter the octagonal well. The vav is a spectacular example of Indo-Islamic architecture and design. The harmonious play of intricate Islamic floral patterns seamlessly fusing into Hindu and Jain symbolism embody the culture and ethos of those times.
